ELIGIBILITY FOR NINE HOLE DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS

This event is targeted towards beginner golfers and players who may now find 18 holes physically difficult.

A beginner could be described as a player that has a high handicap or is new to golf and has not completed their 20 rounds as per the Golflink handicap system. A high handicap is <u>generally</u> regarded as that above 36.

To confirm suitability a player must submit a printout of their Golflink page.

2024 HRDGA District Tournament Conditions of Play

- As per the HRDGA standard conditions of play and host clubs' local rules
- Golf NSW'S Code of Conduct shall apply to all events and competitions organised by HRDGA Ladies Sub Committee
- Tournament Match Committee shall be the HRDGA Ladies Sub Committee
- All events will be decided by Golf Australia recommended countback procedure.
- To be eligible to enter any HRDGA Ladies Event, a player must be an Amateur and have a current GA handicap.
- The Championship is open to Lady members who are affiliated with the HRDGA
- All players must enter on their Golf Australia handicap and play off the Daily Handicap applicable to the host club.
- A Competition Card is classed as being 'returned' when the player has left the official scoring table.
- Caddies are not permitted.
- By entering this tournament, you agree to your images being used for event reporting and promotional purposes unless explicitly requested by the player otherwise.
- The HRDGA Adverse Conditions by law shall apply to all Ladies Events. It is the player's responsibility to take cover and/or leave the course if she considers she may be in danger during lightning strikes.
- Withdrawals: Prior to the draw being made and distributed: full refund. Once draw is made: no refund.
- The draw will be distributed one week prior to event.
