SCONE GOLF CLUB: LADIES OPEN DAY

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PLAY

All female members are entitled to enter the Competition. Bona fide full playing female members of affiliated Golf Clubs are allowed to enter the Competition (see visitor conditions below).

1. EVENTS: 18 Hole Individual Stroke (Scratch Only). (NOTE: Scratch is over the field there is no scratch event in Division 1, 2 or 3). If scores are level, then the winners will be decided by a countback in all events.

Division 1 and 2 Nett, Division 3 Stableford.

2. PRIZES: All players are eligible to win the prizes of The Manning Cup (scratch winner), Runner Up Scratch and 18 Hole Nett Divisions 1, 2 or Stableford Division 3.

Scone players may also win the Beryl Phelps Trophy for the Best Stableford score by Scone player. Players may win the Longest Drive in divisions and the NTP in divisions.

3. HANDICAPS: Handicaps are the player's daily Scone playing handicap for the particular course being played.

4. DIVISIONS: Div 1: 0-18; Div 2: 19-30; Div 3: 31-45 Scone Daily Playing Handicaps. These may be adjusted dependant on entries.

5. BALL COMPETITION: To be determined.

6. COMPETITION FEES: Members and visitors pay the same fee. The fee is \$30 per player (Juniors \$30).

Note: If the Scone Golf Committee decides to call the competition off then all players will be reimbursed their fees.

7. VISITORS: Bona fide visitors are visitors who play the majority of their golf at their home club. Players who are not considered by the Scone Golf Committee to be bona fide or are restricted, discounted, remote country, Golf Connect access or who have similar types of membership can play for a fee of \$60.

8. NOTE: Any prizes that are not collected within 2 months from the completion of the competition will be forfeited.

9. MEDIA: By entering any competition a player (and their parent or guardian if they are under 18) automatically endorses the use of their results and images for media and promotion purposes by Scone Golf Club unless specifically requested by the player in writing prior to the event to the Ladies Captain for such not to be used.

10. *The Scone Golf Committee retains the rights to alter any Rules and Conditions at any time and all decisions of the Scone Golf Committee shall be final.*
